DEAR «FIRST NAME»,

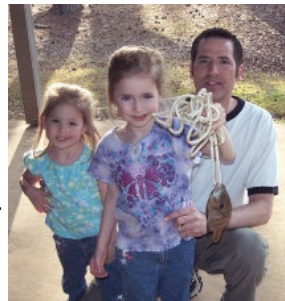

After a time of confession, leaders and students ministered to one another through prayer, asking the Lord to bring healing and restoration to broken lives.
